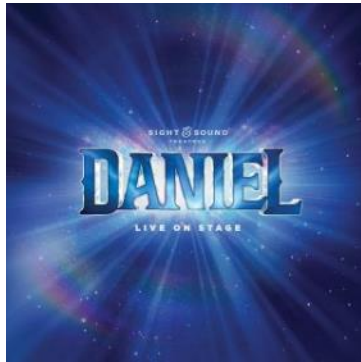
Then, it's time for lunch so we'll turn our coach toward **Kitchen Kettle Village** where you will surely enjoy the delicious, boxed lunch.
